

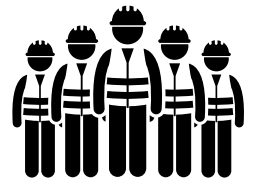

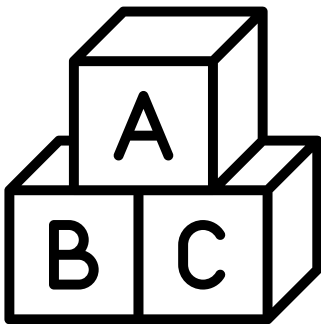
EMPLOYMENT UPSKILLING

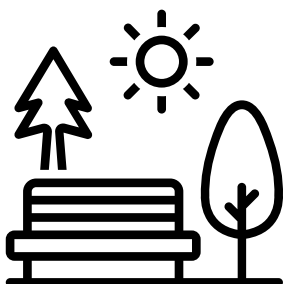
CHILDCARE

As part of this State Government led process, Council will strongly represent the needs and aspirations for the future that our community deserves, building upon the opportunities and optimism from planned projects.

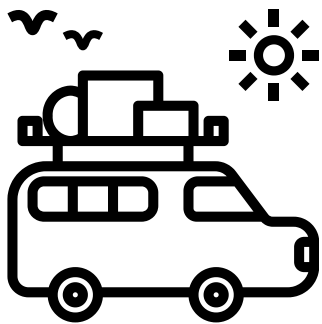

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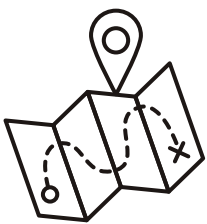
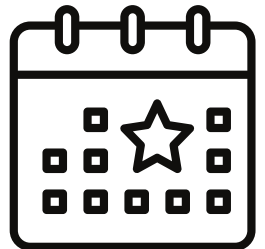


TOURISM

The new \$10m Southern Flinders Ranges National Park will be completed in 2023. Together with the Regional Development Australia Yorke and Mid North, we will define Stage 2 of Gorges SA Walks and commence gathering supporting information for a future grant application.

The Port Pirie SALA Winter Festival will be held in conjunction with the month-long SALA event in August.

Working with an Events Attraction Company, we will secure additional events to our region.



Our Heritage Walks project will be completed, including wayfinding signage linked to a QR code mapping system.

LAND DEVELOPMENT

Council will offer by expression of interest the opportunity to develop council owned land zoned for tourism development which front the Pirie River. We will also commence discussions for development opportunities for Stage 2 Riverfront land.
